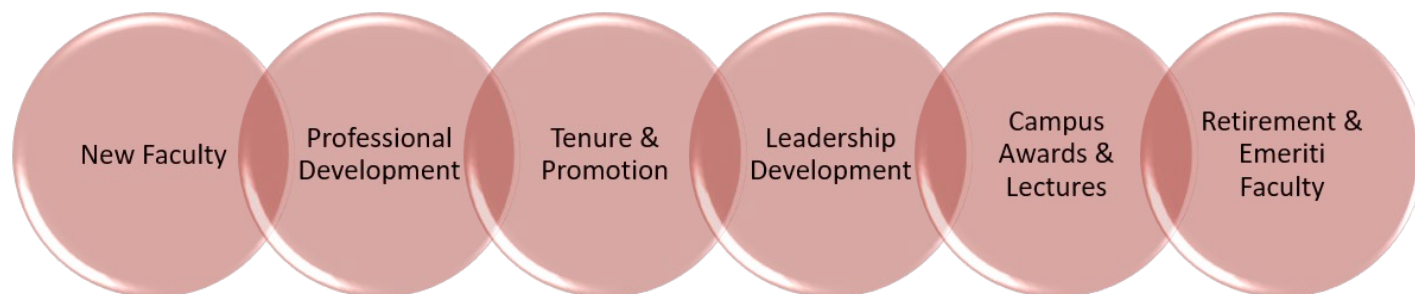


THE OFFICE OF THE VICE PROVOST FOR FACULTY AND ACADEMIC AFFAIRS
